- 3 Calzada de los Frailes – Beautiful tree-lined street.
- 4 Casa de los Venados – Folk art museum.
- 5 Cathedral of San Servacio – Historic cathedral.
- 6 Candelaria Church – One of Mexico's oldest churches.
- 7 Sisal Street – Colorful shops & local boutiques.
- 8 Zací Cenote – Hidden oasis in the heart of town.
- 9 Ex-Convent of San Francisco – End your walk here.

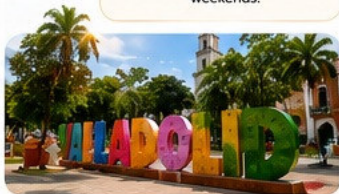
